- Reload your card anytime you shop at Holiday Market with whatever amount of money you plan to spend and 5% of your bill continues to be donated to FAB. You can reload your card using cash or a credit card, and it can be done right at the check-out register before the cashier begins ringing up your order. It's that easy!
- If you currently have a Holiday Market owner loyalty card, you can use both cards when you make a purchase. Thus, you still earn your personal reward points and FAB earns its 5% a win-win deal!

- Purchased sound systems for high school and middle school music rooms
