Here's How It Works:

- Purchase a \$20 Holiday Market gift card from FAB.
- Use this card when you shop at Holiday Market and 5% of the \$20 will be donated back to the FAB.
- Reload your card anytime you shop at Holiday Market with whatever amount of money you plan to spend and 5% of your bill continues to be donated to FAB. You can reload your card using cash or a credit card, and it can be done right at the check-out register before the cashier begins ringing up your order. It's that easy!
- If you currently have a Holiday Market owner loyalty card, you can use both cards when you make a purchase. Thus, you still earn your personal reward points and FAB earns its 5% - a win-win deal!

- Provided more than \$10,000 in classroom assistance to fine arts teachers for such things as
 - Clinicians
 - Field trips to fine arts events
 - Art supplies
 - Dance costumes
- Purchased concert attire for the high school choir, band and orchestra
- Purchased new marching band uniforms
- Provided funding assistance for fine arts extra curricular activities including the marching band, winter guard and drumline
- Raised over \$4,000 to send the 50-member high school Wind Ensemble to perform at the 2008 Michigan Music Conference
- Purchased instruments for the band and orchestra
- Purchased sound systems for high school and middle school music rooms
- Sponsored a used instrument sale to provide low cost, good quality instruments to beginning band and orchestra students
- Refurbished and retrofitted the newly-acquired FHS Marching Band semi-trailer
